## **Church Opening Times**

Windsor Parish Church and SS Stephen & Agnes Church are open most days for individual prayer. All Saints' Church is open on Tuesday & Saturday, and Holy Trinity Church from 9.30-11.30am on Wednesday-Saturday. Please observe social distancing and sanitise your hands Please wear a face covering over mouth and nose.

## **Easing of Lockdown Restrictions**

The safety of our congregation and visitors remains paramount as lockdown restrictions are eased nationally. We ask that you continue to wear a face covering when attending a service in any of the churches and to sanitise your hands. NHS Test and Trace will remain. We will continue to maintain social distancing in the manner in which seating is arranged and to advise against physical contact with those outside your family or bubble. The position regarding congregational singing and sharing the chalice will be continually reviewed and we will advise you accordingly.
