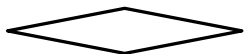

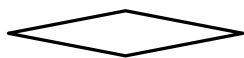


Easing of Lockdown Restrictions

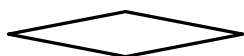
We will continue to maintain social distancing in the manner in which seating is arranged and we will continue to advise against physical contact with those outside your family or bubble. The

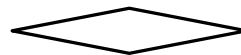
A Morning Prayer

Licensing of Revd Richard Reardon

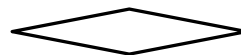

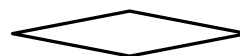

5th September SS Stephen & Agnes Church

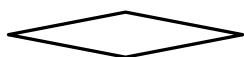

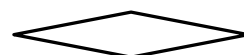
A QR code is now available at the back of the church for you to download the order of service from one of our web sites.

Ride+Stride will be taking place on Saturday the 11th September with a number of churches in the Deanery open that day.

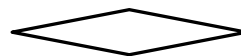
