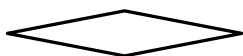
### **New Pathways Bereavement Group**

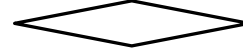
### **Easing of Lockdown Restrictions**

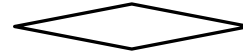


### **Zoom Services from Church**

Thanks to the skill and commitment of our technical team, we have been able to offer live-streamed services from church via Zoom and YouTube since July 2020.

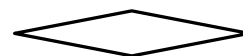
We have now suspended the live-streaming, but we hope to record each service and upload it to [our YouTube page](#) after the service.

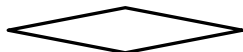
