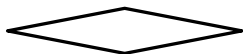

We will continue to maintain social distancing in the manner in which seating is arranged and we will continue to advise against physical contact with those outside your family or bubble. The

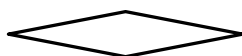

#### **A Service of Quiet Reflection and Prayer**

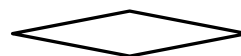

- 19<sup>th</sup> September All Saints' Church

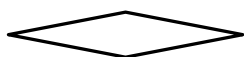

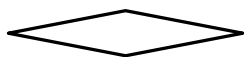


### Service Booklets

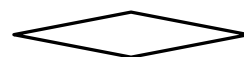
A QR code is now available at the back of the church for you to download the order of service from one of our web sites.

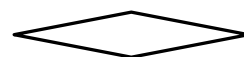
Even though the national restrictions have been lifted we ask you to please continue to observe social distancing and sanitise your hands and please wear a face covering over mouth and nose

### New Pathways Bereavement Group

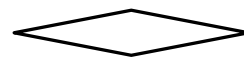

Ride+Stride will be taking place on Saturday the 11<sup>th</sup> September with a number of churches in the Deanery open that day.

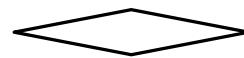
Our churches open will be: -
