St James the Apostle

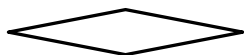
The Collect for the day

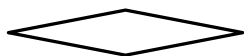


Service Booklets

It is really good to see so many at our 10:00am services.

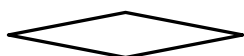

Thanks to the skill and commitment of our technical team, we have been able to offer live-streamed services from church via Zoom and YouTube since July 2020.

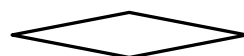
We have now suspended the live-streaming, but we hope to record each service and upload it to our [YouTube page](#) after the service.

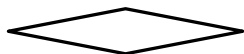

You will need your bank details and the relevant code for your churches.

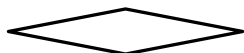

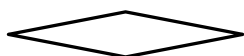

Easing of Lockdown Restrictions

The safety of our congregation and visitors remains paramount as lockdown restrictions are eased nationally.
